

Planning Process: Definitions

Neighborhood Sub-area Committee Members: Property owners, residents, merchants, anchor institutions, neighborhood associations, interested parties, etc. from particular areas of the neighborhood.

Steering Committee: 13 individuals representing neighborhood groups* who are representative of the Kendall-Whittier Task Force. Ex-officio members include Councilors Baker and Patrick. The Steering Committee is designed to remain constant throughout the planning process.

Kendall-Whittier Task Force: Collaborative group made up of community leaders representing neighborhood residents and organizations. Principle planning group for the neighborhood.

Tulsa Development Authority (TDA): City's redevelopment authority. TDA is responsible for implementing the Urban Renewal Plan for the Kendall-Whittier Neighborhood.

Tulsa Metropolitan Area Planning Commission: City's planning commission. TMAPC is responsible for making recommendations to the City Council pertaining to the urban renewal and neighborhood masterplan.

City Council: City's governing body. Amendments to the urban renewal, neighborhood masterplan and Comprehensive Plan for the Tulsa Metropolitan Area must be approved by the City Council.
