

RESOLUTION NO. 5882

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FROM TAX INCREMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 (a/k/a BRADY VILLAGE TIF), TIF GRANT APPLICATION #7, FOR PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF IMPROVEMENTS LOCATED IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT -OF-WAY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE BRADY VILLAGE TIF**

**WHEREAS**, the Tulsa Development Authority (hereinafter referred to as Authority), a public body corporate, is designated and authorized to administer provisions of Tax Increment District Number One (a/k/a Brady Village Tax Increment District Number 1), according to the Plan as prepared and formatted according to Title 62 O.S., Section 854, paragraphs 1, 4, 7, 13 and 17; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Authority, in its capacity as the public entity to administer provisions of said Tax Increment District, as provided in Title 62 O.S., Section 854, has reviewed the staff's recommendation for the allocation of currently available funds to be granted to private (includes private non-profit) property owners in an amount not to exceed Sixteen Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty-Seven and 25/100 Dollars (\$16,737.25) to implement designated, eligible and approved public streetscape improvements for the purchase of pole banners, brackets and installation in the public right-of-way and park property in accordance with the Brady Village Infill Development Design Guidelines (excluding professional or design fees), as amended from time to time and immediate need, as set forth in said plan; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Authority Resolution No. 5616 dated February 15, 2011 established the TIF Grant Participation process; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Authority recognizes the Executive Director of the Authority as the person in charge of implementing the plan in accordance with the provisions, authorizations and respective delegations contained therein; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Brady Arts District TIF Grant Committee comprised of the Board of Directors of the Brady Village Property Owners Association and the Executive Director of the Authority did review TIF Grant Application #7 submitted by the John Hope Franklin Center for Reconciliation, Inc. for the purchase of pole banners and brackets and installation upon the following property:

1. The East side of North Detroit Avenue (7 banners) and the West side of North Elgin Avenue (4 banners), both adjacent to the John Hope Franklin Memorial Reconciliation Park; and,

2. The John Hope Franklin Memorial Reconciliation Park (17 banners); and

**WHEREAS**, The Brady Arts District TIF Grant Committee did find: the project to be in substantial conformance with the Brady Arts District streetscape guidelines; Infrastructure Development Process (IDP) plan No. 5574, as revised, and the proposed expenses to be eligible, did therefore vote and pass to recommend said application for the TIF Grant Application #7 reimbursement program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Authority recognizes the Finance Department, City of Tulsa as the entity administering TIF funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TULSA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**, that:

**Section 1.** The Board of Commissioners of the Authority accepts the TIF Grant Committee's recommendation for expenditure of funds for TIF Grant #7 to John Hope Franklin Center for Reconciliation, Inc., a non-profit private property owner, in an amount not to exceed Sixteen Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty-Seven and 25/100 Dollars (\$16,737.25) to implement designated, eligible and approved public streetscape improvements for the purchase of pole banners, brackets and installation in the public right-of-way and park property as being appropriate and in accordance with the requirements of the Brady Village Tax Increment District Number One Project Plan, in accordance with the Brady Village Infill Development Design Guidelines (excluding professional or design fees), as amended from time to time and immediate need, as set forth in said plan and to implement designated minimum, eligible and approved public streetscape improvements in public right-of-way in accordance with the Brady Arts District Small Area Plan Streetscape Summary Report (excluding professional or design fees), as amended from time to time.

**Section 2.** The Board of Commissioners of the Authority hereby directs and authorizes the Finance Department, City of Tulsa to set up a project account to which funds for eligible and



recommended TIF Grant Application #7 reimbursement requests in an amount not to exceed Sixteen Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty-Seven and 25/100 Dollars (\$16,737.25) may be appropriated; subject to final approval by the TDA Board of Commissioners for reimbursement of eligible expenses to be determined by the Authority after completion of the streetscape banner installation.

**Section 3.** The Board of Commissioners of the Authority hereby directs and advises the Executive Director or his designee and the Finance Department, City of Tulsa to proceed with the establishing a project account for encumbrance of available funds for said improvements in an amount not to exceed Sixteen Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty-Seven and 25/100 Dollars (\$16,737.25).

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
