

RESOLUTION NO. 6157

**RESOLUTION APPROVING SELECTION OF A FIRM FOR
RELOCATION AND CONSULTING SERVICES
FOR THE PEARL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Tulsa Development Authority (“TDA”) has previously entered into negotiations with Universal Field Services, Inc. for relocation and consulting services to the TDA in support of and assistance to TDA’s activities in acquisition of certain parcels for the City of Tulsa Elm Creek/6th Street Drainage, Detention and Conveyance Plan Project (“Project”); and,

WHEREAS, the Tulsa Development Authority (“TDA”) has successfully negotiated an agreement with Universal Field Services, Inc. in the form attached hereto for the provision of professional relocation and consulting services to the TDA in support of and assistance to TDA’s activities with regard to the Project; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Commissioners of TDA that is in the best interest of the TDA, the City of Tulsa and the citizens of the City, that the Tulsa Development Authority (TDA) execute the Agreement for Relocation Services with Universal Field Services, Inc. in the form attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TULSA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, that:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of the Tulsa Development Authority does hereby approve the Agreement for Relocation Services with Universal Field Services, Inc., in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the Tulsa Development Authority (TDA) to execute said Agreement for the provision of professional relocation and consulting services to the TDA in support of and assistance to TDA’s activities in acquisition of certain parcels for the City of Tulsa Elm Creek/6th Street Drainage, Detention and Conveyance Plan Project (“Project”).

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
