

RESOLUTION NO. 6256

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR
DOWNTOWN WALKABILITY STUDY, TULSA, OKLAHOMA**

WHEREAS, the Tulsa Development Authority (hereinafter referred to as Authority), a public body corporate, is organized and operated for the benefit of the citizens of Tulsa, Oklahoma; and,

WHEREAS, the Downtown Coordinating Council has requested that the Authority provide \$10,000.00 to assist in the funding of a Downtown Walkability Study for Tulsa, Oklahoma by Jeff Speck, a nationally acclaimed authority, for the development of strategies and actions to bring about significant increases in the number of people walking, cycling and breathing more life into downtown Tulsa; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Tulsa Development Authority has determined that it is in the best interest of the Authority, the City of Tulsa and its citizens for the Authority to provide \$10,000.00 to assist in the funding of a Downtown Walkability Study for Tulsa, Oklahoma and implementation of recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TULSA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, that:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of the Authority does hereby approve the Authority to expend and provide \$10,000.00 to the Tulsa Downtown Coordinating Council to assist in the funding of a Downtown Walkability Study by Jeff Speck for Tulsa, Oklahoma and implementation of recommendations.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners of the Authority hereby directs the Executive Director of the Authority to proceed with the expenditure of available funds for said Downtown Walkability Study and implementation of recommendations in an amount not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
