

RESOLUTION NO. 6333

**RESOLUTION – APPROVAL OF MINOR AMENDMENT OF BOUNDARIES
OF THE NORTH PEORIA AVENUE TAX
INCREMENT DISTRICT NUMBER FOUR, TULSA, OKLAHOMA**

WHEREAS, The Tulsa City Council did, by Ordinance No. 20387, adopt and approve the Revised Project Plan for the North Peoria Avenue Tax Increment District Number Four of the City of Tulsa (North Peoria TIF), effective July 15, 2002; and,

WHEREAS, the Tulsa Development Authority (TDA) is designated and authorized, pursuant to the terms of the said Revised Project Plan, as the public entity to carry out and administer the provisions of the said Revised Project Plan; and,

WHEREAS, a request has been submitted to the Tulsa Development Authority (TDA) to approve a minor amendment of the project boundaries for the North Peoria TIF by adding 5.342 acres (a 1.04% increase in total acreage from 507.52 acres to 512.862 acres) as set forth on the legal description attached hereto as Attachment “A” and as illustrated on the aerial photo map attached hereto as Attachment “B”; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Commissioners of the Tulsa Development Authority (TDA) that it is in the best interest of the TDA, the City of Tulsa and the citizens of the City that the Tulsa Development Authority (TDA) for it to approve said minor amendment of the North Peoria TIF.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TULSA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, that:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of the Tulsa Development Authority (TDA) does hereby approve a minor amendment of the project boundaries for the North Peoria Avenue Tax Increment Number Four, Tulsa, Oklahoma, by adding 5.342 acres (a 1.04% increase in total acreage) as set forth on the legal description attached hereto as Attachment “A” and as illustrated on the aerial photo map attached hereto as Attachment “B”.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.


