Settlement agreement provides for dismissal of lawsuit upon Plaintiffs' failure to close sale of property. TDA and Plaintiffs signed a Redevelopment Agreement effective April 16, 2013. Wilkins defaulted on the Agreement and it was terminated by TDA. Termination action appealed to arbitration.</p> <p>- <b>Arbitrator granted TDA's Motion for Summary Judgment on 10-5-17. Wilkins Motion for New Trial denied. TDA has filed a Motion to confirm the arbitration decision in the District Court case.</b></p>
Other	<b>Novus Homes (Wilkins)</b>		<b>CV-2016-998</b>	<p>Filed by Wilkins seeking declaratory judgment that TDA violated open meeting act with regard to issuance of Block 44 RFP and injunction against TDA proceeding with sale of its property in Block 44 pursuant to RFP issued following the April, 2016 TDA Board meeting. Request for temporary restraining order was denied. Temporary injunction hearing pending. Special Counsel Jim Weger is assisting TDA General Counsel in defense of this matter.</p> <p>- Counsel for TDA has filed a Motion for Summary Judgment. The Court has denied the Motion for Summary Judgment. Counsel for TDA has filed a Motion to Reconsider. - Motion to Reconsider denied.</p> <p>- Counsel for the Wilkins has withdrawn.</p> <p>- <b>Case remains pending.</b></p>

TDA</b>		<b>CV-2017-1049</b>	<p>Filed by Tulsa City Councilor Vanessa Hall-Harper (in her individual capacity) and others alleging violation of the Open Meeting Act. Plaintiffs are claiming that the Agenda for the January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017 meeting failed to adequately describe the subject matter to be considered under Agenda item 7(i).</p> <p>Hearing on Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Injunction set for 8-31-17 continued at Plaintiff's request to 9-27-17. Second hearing cancelled at request of Plaintiffs.</p> <p>Plaintiffs amended their Petition on 10-4-17. TDA General Counsel has filed an Entry of Appearance for all named Defendants. TDA will proceed with discovery requests and a motion for summary judgment.</p> <p>- <b>Case remains pending.</b></p>
