

RESOLUTION NO. 6561

**RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT FOR
TULSA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FUND 711 (LANSING
BUSINESS & DEVELOPMENT FUND) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Tulsa Development Authority (TDA) has previously approved a budget for fiscal year 2018-2019; and,

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the TDA has advised that it is necessary for the orderly and efficient operation of the TDA that an amendment of Fund 711 expenditures in said budget should be approved by the TDA Board of Commissioners to provide as follows:

- a. An increase of Six Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$6,900.00) for CIP Buildings (Org 7119000, Object 541104); and
- b. A decrease of Two Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Six and 07/100 Dollars (2,236.07) for IT equipment (Org 7119000, Object 542703); and

WHEREAS, the TDA Board has determined that said amendment should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TULSA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, to-wit:

Section 1. That the Board of Commissioners of the Tulsa Development Authority does hereby approve and adopt an amendment of the previously approved a budget for Fund 711 (Lansing Business & Development Fund) for fiscal year 2018-2019 to provide as follows:

- a. An increase of Six Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$6,900.00) for CIP Buildings (Org 7119000, Object 541104); and,
- b. A decrease of Two Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Six and 07/100 Dollars (2,236.07) for IT equipment (Org 7119000, Object 542703).

Section 2. The Finance Department of the City of Tulsa is directed to issue payments drawn from Fund 711 in accordance with the amended budget as provided in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
